**T**he Defense Department's recently formed task force is seeking comments on the controversial National Security Personnel System and AFGE is encouraging everyone to write to the task group about the system's failures and problems.

The three-member task force will hold two public meetings on June 25-26 at the Hyatt Arlington in northern Virginia to collect comments on NSPS. The panel on June 25 will hear testimony from experts who have testified before Congress on NSPS, including AFGE. On June 26, the panel will hear from members of the public invited to testify based on their comments submitted in advance.

Comments are accepted through June 26, but if you want to be considered to testify, the panel must receive your comments by June 18. Comments are only accepted through regular snail mail. You need to put your thoughts down on paper as soon as possible.
