

Comments on Proposed NSPS Regulations RIN 3206-AK76/0790-AH82

The final sentence says that NSPS should not be judged or compared to DHS. But in truth it has been in particular by upper DoD management who eagerly look forward to enforcing these same principles of the much tinier DHS on the gigantic DoD.
